

Most churches of Christ hold services on Sunday morning and evening, and this congregation did so for many years. However, in the summer of 2013, the elders decided to add another worship service on Sunday morning and eliminate the service on Sunday night. This was done primarily to reduce the amount of time spent traveling on Sunday as our members live in different areas of northern Virginia and a few drive 45 minutes to over an hour to reach our facility in Purcellville.

Unlike many congregations that have two morning services and bring the same lesson at each one, the sermon topics at Purcellville's Sunday morning services are different. For that and other reasons, the elders ask the church's members to attend both services and Sunday school, which is held between them.

The lessons of the first worship service are typically expository and member-focused. Throughout 2014, the year-long theme for the first worship service is "Know Your Bible." Each Sunday morning, the lesson is about one or more books of the Bible. In 2015, the theme of the first lesson is scheduled to be on subjects such as "Obeying the Commandments," "In Christ," "Abounding," etc.

Lessons for the second worship service are flexible and constitute short series. They are flexible in that they allow for "need-based" sermons, special occasions, etc. The short series include lessons on "The Seed," "Basic Bible Lessons," (which is the current subject), etc., and are typically topical and visitor-friendly.
